

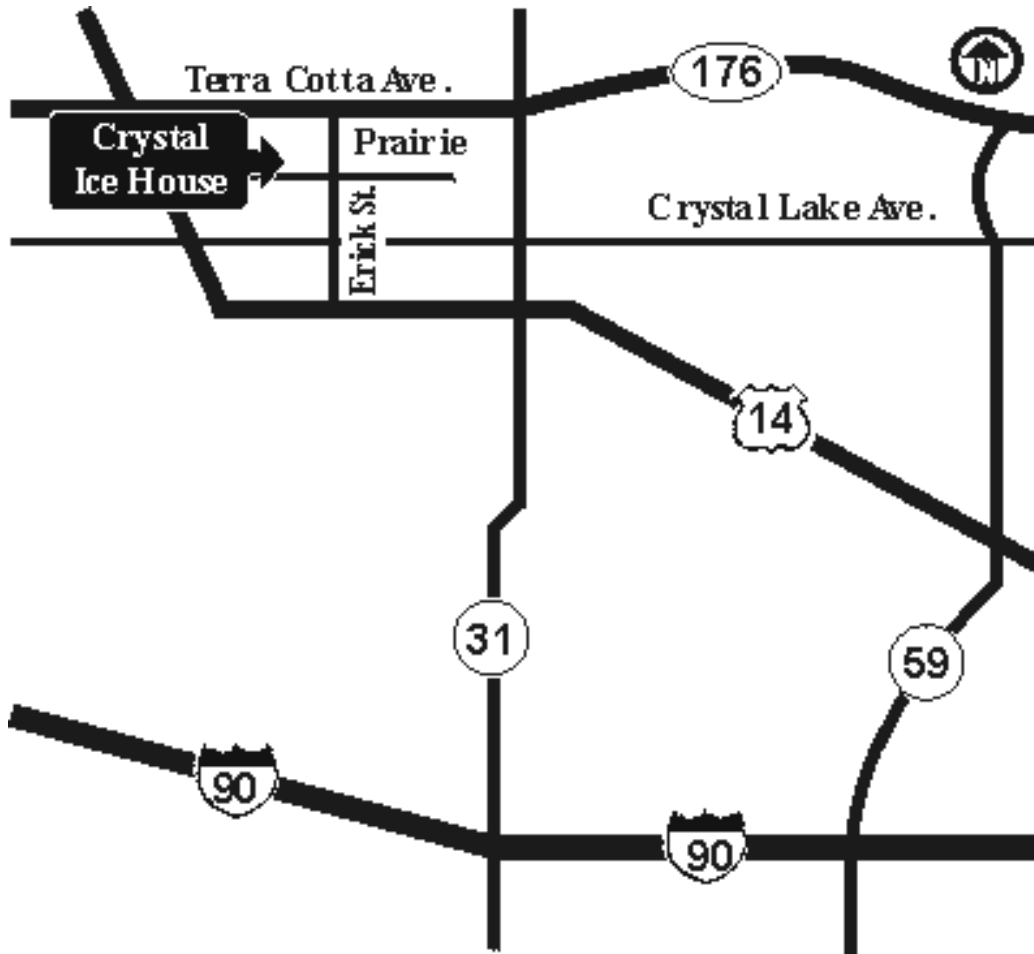

Crystal Lake is located near the intersection of Rt-31 and Rt-176 in northeast Illinois, approx. 50 miles northwest of Chicago.

From I-94: West on Rt. 176. Go west on Rt. 176 (Terra Cotta Ave.) to Erick St. Go south on Erick St. to Prairie St. Go west on Prairie St. to Crystal Ice House. Arena is on the north side of Prairie St.

From I-294: North on I-294 to I-290. Go west on I-290 to I-90. Go west on I-90 to Rt. 31. Exit and go north to Hwy. 176. Go west on Hwy. 176 to Erick St. Go south on Erick St. to Prairie St. Go west on Prairie St. Arena is on the north side of Prairie St.

From I-290: West on I-290 to I-90 west. Go west on I-90 to Rt. 31. Go north on Rt. 31. Go north to Hwy. 176. Go west on Hwy. 176 to Erick St. Go south on Erick St. to Prairie St. Go west on Prairie St. Arena is on the north side of Prairie St.

From I-43: I-43 to Rt-12 (Lake Geneva). Rt-12 South (east) to Rt-31. Rt-31 South to Rt-176 (Crystal Lake). West on Rt-176 to Erick St. South on Erick St. to Prairie St. West on Prairie to Crystal Ice House. Arena is on the right side of the road.

Pro shop – a branch of Jerry’s Hockey Warehouse located on-premise. Hours of operation mirror rink hours and Glenn Busch, the manager, will be sure that Jerry’s is open to sharpen skates and sell laces, mouth guards, neck guards, etc. before and during Girls Round-Robin games.

Skate sharpening – see above

Snack Bar – on-premise snack bar with breakfast as well as lunch/dinner items. Hours of operation mirror rink hours, and we will coordinate schedules with the manager to be sure that it is open during Round Robin games.

Parking – approximately 170 spaces including handicap spaces.

Welcome/sign-in desk - Sign-in tables will be setup in the ice arena lobby to greet the teams arriving to play their games. We will inform/remind them of their game time, rink and locker room assignments, Home or Away designation, provide them a guide to their rink and locker rooms, make notes for name pronunciations, prepare scoresheets, and inform the manager of any special instructions AHAI might wish to communicate.
